

Southminster Presbyterian Church Outreach Committee Charter

Committee Purpose/Mission

To make Southminster aware of the constantly changing social needs of God's world, and the call to spread the word of God and invite others into a relationship with Jesus Christ. Use this awareness to motivate and facilitate active participation in mission opportunities by Southminster members.

Committee Leadership and Membership

Chairperson: A member of SPC who is nominated by the serving Ruling Elders assigned to the Outreach Committee and ratified by Session. May be but not necessarily one of the serving Ruling Elders.

Membership:

- Three serving Ruling Elders of three classes. One of these elders will be the formal link to Session.
- The Chairpersons of the Mission Subcommittee and Transformational Mission Fund LLC.
- Members of the congregation who are passionate about mission at SPC and appropriately represent the church's demographics and fill out needed skills on the committee.

Staff Liaison: Associate Pastor for Mission and New Member Assimilation

Responsibilities and Accountabilities

1. Develop and maintain a strategy to continuously increase the number of people actively involved in the mission life of SPC. Set goals and track progress.
2. Set broad outlines of criteria to be used in determining both mission giving and congregational participation in mission projects.
3. Carry out the SPC vision and Session Initiatives in the mission context.
4. Coordinate activities and projects of the Mission Subcommittee and the Transformational Mission Fund LLC to carry out the SPC vision.
5. Actively foster synergy and teamwork between the Mission Subcommittee and the Transformational Mission Fund LLC.
6. Encourage and coordinate communication between subcommittees, LLCs and the Congregation.
7. Ratify the Chairperson of the Mission Subcommittee.
8. Supervise budget and spending of the Mission Subcommittee and coordinate in this area with the Transformational Mission Fund LLC as may be directed by Session.
9. Keep Session well informed.
